Currently the Company has three distribution facilities in Texas City, Beaumont and Victoria and service the following 17 Texas counties: Brazoria, Calhoun, Chambers, DeWitt, Galveston, Hardin, Jackson, Jasper, Jefferson, Lavaca, Liberty, Matagorda, Newton, Orange, Sabine, Victoria and Wharton.

In 2010, in conjunction with its 100th anniversary celebration, the Del Papa family initiated a Company-wide college scholarship endowment at all the community colleges and four-year universities in the communities where the company conducts business.
