Poster Quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Was the presentation supported by a balance of appropriate text and graphics? ➤ Is there a logical flow to the information? ➤ Was the poster pleasant to look at? 	10	
Presenter Quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Did the presenter lend confidence in the work with their presentation? ➤ Did the presenter answer questions appropriately and demonstrate a good overall knowledge of the topic? 	10
