Using your own **digital camera**, learn how to shoot photographs and write stories for newsletters, magazines and websites.

Submit your best digital image files for possible publication in *Coast Monthly and Galveston Monthly Magazine*.

Take photographs and write a story on a Galveston pilot and his/her plane for the website of the **Scholes International Airport Galveston**.

Shoot a photo assignment for the *East End Historical District Newsletter*.

Photograph **adoptable kittens, puppies, cats and dogs** at the Galveston Island Humane Society.

Have fun swimming in the pool at Texas A&M and in the Gulf of Mexico while at the Galveston State Park.

Using one of your photographs, design, print, write, address, stamp and mail a greeting card to your parents.

Produce your own photographic mini portfolio.

Finish the week with an **art exhibit and sale** of your best photographs at the auditorium in CLB 100 on Friday from 6:00pm-8:00pm. Campers please bring at least four \$5 bills, so you can provide change during the sale of your artwork.

There will be a brief Mardi Gras bead toss and awards ceremony from about 8:00pm-8:15pm. Parents and relatives are invited and encouraged to attend.

Requirements: Interest in photography, photojournalism and magazine photography. Knowledge to operate your own digital camera, download your images from your camera to a computer, send photographs by e-mail using your own e-mail account and transfer images from your computer onto a flash drive.

Equipment needed: Your own digital camera with zoom lens. If you don't already have a digital camera, consider the Nikon Z50 mirrorless camera with Nikkor ZDX 16-50mm VR zoom lens or a Panasonic Lumix FZ80 18.1 Megapixels with a 60x zoom lens.

Supplies needed: Please bring your USB cable to download your best images from your camera to the computer

- 1 card reader
- 2 rechargeable camera batteries and your battery charger as we shoot about a thousand images
- 2 brand new memory cards 32 GB each
- 2 brand new flash drives USB 3.0, 32 GB to transfer and save your best images each day. The normal size plastic flash drives like the PNY and San Disk are good. Please do not bring the miniature metal flash drives as they dent easily and then won't fit in the USB slot.
- If available, bring your digital camera instruction manual
- Small camera bag
- Tripod
- Laptop computer loaded with Adobe Photoshop (**Optional**)
- 3 plastic zip lock bags to keep moisture, dust and sand from getting in your camera and lens
- 1 #2 pencil, 1 pen, 1 12-inch ruler, 1 \$.73 postage stamp, 1 small notebook for writing down quotes and taking notes during interviews, 1 roll Scotch **permanent** double stick tape
- Water bottle, mosquito repellent, hand sanitizer and sunscreen

Clothing to bring: Athletic shoes, modest swimsuit, shorts, comfortable shoes, blue jeans (to keep mosquitoes from biting your legs).

Note to Parents: Please don't worry if you are unable to locate any of the needed supplies. **Except for camera batteries**, the campers can purchase the items at Target or Wal-Mart in Galveston. **For questions, please contact me directly on my cell phone at (409)771-5668.** Thank you very much for selecting this photography camp.
